## Seeking Input on Law Library Changes

Dramatic changes are coming to the Stark County Law Library as well as other county law libraries around Ohio. In 2005 and 2006 the Ohio Legislature enacted the following changes related to law libraries:

- Employees previously paid by the county will have their salaries assumed by the association in 20% increments over five years, so that by 2011 those employees will be paid entirely by the association.
- Counties will have the option to charge rent and utilities to the law library beginning in 2008.

The library is responsible for 20% of three employees' salaries in 2007, and as the percentages increase over the next several years, the financial impact will be seen in additional cancellations of books and perhaps the reduction of online resources and staff. The effects will be more extreme if the library is required to pay rent and utilities.

The input of the library's membership is valued. The library's board members are discussing with the Stark County Bar Association the status of the library and also seek your comments on what can be done on the local level to ensure the continuation of the library's essential services.
