be sure to check with the library. We have access to articles through a number of databases that cover a wide subject range of journals and newspapers in addition to legal and medical periodicals, and we may be able to send the article to you at no cost.

## Library Funding Still Threatened

HB 66 passed the Ohio House of Representatives and is now being considered by the Senate. As currently written the bill includes provisions that will devastate law library funding beginning in 2007. 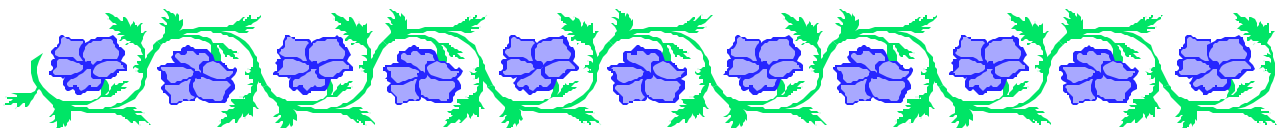

## LOG ON TO OUR CATALOG 24/7

1. Open the telnet software on your computer (for example: HyperTerminal)
2. Enter a name for the connection (for example: Stark County Law Library)
3. In the host address line, enter: `sirsi.starklawlibrary.org`
4. In the "connect using" box, choose TCP/IP
5. At the login prompt type "public" and at the password prompt type "public"
6. The program will then load, and this may take 1-2 minutes
7. Choose (1) Library Catalog
8. Follow the on-screen instructions to search for books by author, title or subject
