LOG ON TO OUR CATALOG 24/7

1. Open the telnet software on your computer (for example: HyperTerminal)
2. Enter a name for the connection (for example: Stark County Law Library)
3. In the host address line, enter: sirs1.starklawlibrary.org
4. In the "connect using" box, choose TCP/IP
5. At the login prompt type "public" and at the password prompt type "public"
6. The program will then load, and this may take 1-2 minutes
7. Choose (1) Library Catalog
8. Follow the on-screen instructions to search for books by author, title or subject
